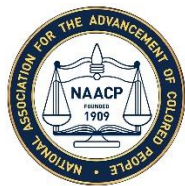

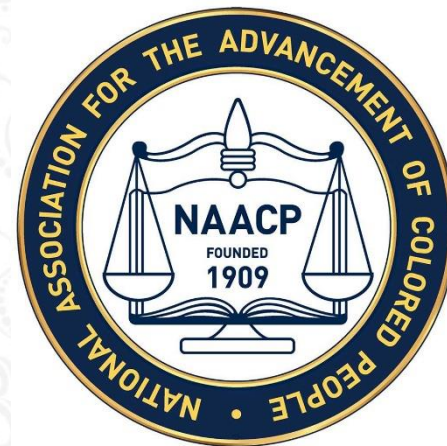
History of the NAACP

The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) was formed in 1909 by a group of black and white citizens. In response to injustice that many Americans confronted solely because of race, today, the NAACP, the oldest and largest civil rights organization in the world, continues to focus major efforts at increasing Voter empowerment, educational excellence, and individual responsibility, thus creating an infrastructure for economic and social development and new effective ways to develop young leaders. The strength of the NAACP lies in their memberships which are organized in more than 1700 adult branches, 500 youth and college units and 38 state and area conferences serving all 50 states, the Districts of Columbia, Germany, Spain and Japan.

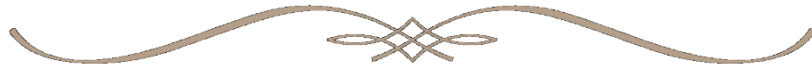
